

Digital Scavenger Hunt

Objective: To find items on a scavenger hunt by taking digital pictures.

Description: Form groups with four to six runners in each group. Designate the running boundaries. The runners in each group must stay together on the run. Each group has a digital camera or a cell phone camera and a list of things to photograph. Designate a certain time period for groups to take all the pictures on the list and get back. Each team member must take at least one of the pictures. When the runners return, the coach will check to verify that all the items have been photographed. The team that returns first with all the correct items is the winner. If a team does not have all the items, they continue the activity until they have returned with all the items. Place a time limit on the hunt. If the teams have not found all the items, the team with the most items is the winner.

Sample list of items to take pictures of:
Sign with letter "r" in it
Black Dog
Sign that says name of the town
Pine cone
Cow
Tractor (not a riding lawnmower)
Person riding a bike
Two birds in the same picture
Flowers in bloom
Sprinkler watering yard or water running out of hose

Variations: (1) Group members with the exception of the photographer must be in the picture. (2) Add more difficult items to the list and remove the requirement the runners have to stay together and be in the picture. The group will need multiple cameras for this.

Equipment: One digital camera for each team and a list of requirements to fulfill.
